


INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

All Exhibitors are required to provide an original certificate of insurance showing liability insurance of not less than \$1,000,000/each occurrence and \$1,000,000 aggregate in effect during the dates of the expo. The certificate must name Data 2.0, Inc. as an additional insured. If an original certificate is not submitted, exhibitors are prohibited from setting up their exhibit booth or otherwise participating in BlockWorld 2018 .

All BlockWorld 2018 exhibitors are required to submit proof of insurance to Emily at emily@devnetwork.com by August 24, 2018.

How do I obtain Insurance for BlockWorld 2018?

How much does the Insurance Cost?

To exhibit at BlockWorld 2018 from September 13 - September 14 (2 day expo) the insurance is quoted at \$130.

When is the Certificate of Insurance Due?

The certificate of insurance is due to emily@devnetwork.com by August 24, 2018.

This is a policy that most large tradeshow have in place to protect exhibitors and attendees. In order to exhibit with us, this certificate must be obtained.
